DIGITAL COMMUNITY CHOIR – ST HELENS

We (leo&hyde) are looking for residents of St Helens and the surrounding area to be involved in virtual community choir for an exciting new song called Out of the Earth, inspired by workshops local people who imaged what St Helens might look like in 100 years if you think about the future positively. The song will be featured in a music video with the art of virtual reality artist, [Rosie Summers](#).

You don't have to have any singing experience to take part in this. A community choir is all about community and doing something together. It's a time to let your voice be heard alongside other people.

Learning

- 1) Go to leoandhyde.com/sthelens to watch or download the learning tracks and lyric sheets to sing along to
- 2) Listen to the tracks and pick the one you'd like to sing (you can sing more than one if you like)
 - there are 4 different **parts** for the different **difficulties and lengths**
- 3) Practice singing along to your chosen part thinking about
 - Staying on **Pitch**
 - Keeping the **Rhythm** and keeping the **rests** in mind

Recording

- 4) Set up a device (1) on which you can listen to the tracks with headphones (e.g. phone/laptop)
 - Headphones are important as we don't want recordings where we can hear the backing track (imagine you are a recording artist in a recording studio). This makes it easy to edit the vocals together
- 5) Set up a device (2) so that you can record a video (e.g. phone/tablet)
- 6) Set device 2 recording
- 7) Get into frame of the video so we can see you
- 8) Play the track in your headphones on device 1 and sing your part along with the track

Sending it off

- 9) Once you are happy with the recording, send it to your tutors if you're learning at school or college, or directly to us at sthelens@leoandhyde.com via wetransfer.com or another similar website otherwise. **Send by 11:59pm 22nd March 2021**
- 10) We will email you to let you know we have received it.
