

DIGITAL COMMUNITY CHOIR – SANDBACH

You don't have to have any singing experience to take part in this exciting music video project. A community choir is all about community and doing something together. It's a time to let your voice be heard alongside other people.

Learning

- 1) Go to leoandhyde.com/sandbach to watch or download the learning tracks and lyric sheets to sing along to
- 2) Listen to the tracks and pick the one you'd like to sing (you can sing more than one if you like)
 - there are 2 different **parts** (melody and harmony)

Recording

- 3) Set up a device (1) on which you can listen to the tracks with headphones (e.g. phone/laptop)
 - Headphones are important as we don't want recordings where we can hear the backing track (imagine you are a recording artist in a recording studio). This makes it easy to edit the vocals together
- 4) Set up a device (2) so that you can record a video (e.g. phone/tablet)
- 5) Set device 2 recording
- 6) Get into frame of the video so we can see you
- 7) Play the track in your headphones on device 1 and sing your part along with the track

Sending it off
